- worldwide, all subjects, no quotas
- Humboldtians as hosts
- host contribution





Research Fellowships

Feodor Lynen Research Fellowships for postdoctoral researchers

- 6 - 24 months
- endowment: dependent on age, marital status and country
Example: an unmarried 33-year old fellow in the United States receives between 2,500 EUR and 2,800 EUR per month, in France approx. 2,300 EUR, in Poland approx. 2,500 EUR
- for scientists who completed their doctorate less than 4 years ago

Feodor Lynen Research Fellowships for experienced researchers

- 6 - 18 months, may be divided up into three blocks
- for scientists who completed their doctorate less than 12 years ago





Application requirements

Postdoctoral researchers

- doctorate
- academic publications
- agreement by academic host
- autonomous research project
- knowledge of German and/or English

Experienced researchers


- own, clearly defined academic profile
- comprehensive list of academic publications
- agreement by academic host
- autonomous research project
- knowledge of German and/or English





Application procedure

- applications at any time to the Humboldt Foundation directly
- assessment by independent expert reviewers
- decision by Humboldt Foundation Selection Committees
- duration of procedure: approx. 3 to 6 months





Sponsorship provisions

- travel expenses
- language courses or allowance towards language course *
- fellowship
- family allowance
- additional funding for project costs and scientific equipment

(*not applicable to Feodor Lynen Research Fellowships)






Sponsorship provisions

- Phillip Franz von Siebold Award: 50.000 €


* Applications are not possible (with the exception of the Sofja Kovalevskaja Award). Scientists in Germany need to nominate candidates for an award.





Origin of Guest Researchers


2002 - 2006: a total of 2,478 new research fellows from abroad





Disciplines of Guest Researchers


2002 - 2006: a total of 2,478 new research fellows from abroad
